(Letter dated 4 March 1952 from the Acting Director-General of the World Health Organization to the Officer in Charge of the Department of Social Affairs)

I have your letter of 14 February (ref: SOA 317/2/01(8)) concerning the request of the General Assembly that the specialized agencies submit their views on the form and content of the proposed Covenant on economic, social and cultural rights, for the information and guidance of the Commission on Human Rights.

The recommendations concerning the draft Covenant on Human Rights which had been adopted by the Third Committee of the General Assembly before 22 January 1952 were brought to the attention of the Executive Board of WHO on that day, which was the last day of its ninth session. Since the debate on human rights was still in progress and no decision had been made by the General Assembly, the Board noted the report without making any recommendation.

In this circumstance, the Director-General of WHO considers that he can add nothing to the statement which was presented to the thirteenth session of the Economic and Social Council in document E/2057/Add.1.
