With reference to your letter of August 10, 1953, regarding the United States draft resolutions on the development of action programmes for the Commission on Human Rights (SOA 317/07 (1)), I have the honour to inform you that the Swedish Government are inclined to think that the Commission on Human Rights should concentrate their efforts on the drafting of the covenants on human rights and measures of implementation with a view to complete this work as soon as possible. The Swedish Government are thus not prepared for the time being to comment on the United States draft resolutions on annual reports (doc. E/CN.4/L.266/Rev.2), advisory services (doc. E/CN.4/L.267/Rev.1), and studies of specific aspects of human rights (doc. E/CN.4/L.268).
