Observations of the Specialized Agencies received by the Secretary-General pursuant to Economic and Social Council resolution 501 B (XVI)

World Health Organization

Resolution 501 B (XVI) of the Economic and Social Council concerning the draft International Conventions on Human Rights has been carefully studied, together with the report of the ninth session of the Commission on Human Rights, document E/2447.

I have no particular comment to offer on this report which is comprehensive and gives a very clear picture of the stage reached by the Commission on Human Rights in its preparation of the two draft International Convenants on Human Rights and measures of implementation.

I would like, however, to state that, in my opinion, Article 53 of the draft Covenant on Civil and Political Rights, which was deleted by the Commission on Human Rights at its ninth session, did serve a useful purpose and was likely to avoid any difficulty in the interpretation of the competence of the Human Rights Committee. It is believed that any action that might be envisaged in order to have Article 53 re-instated would help to clarify the whole field of the methods of implementation of the Covenants.
