**Official communiqué of the 5531st (closed) meeting of
the Security Council**

**Held in private at Headquarters, New York, on Friday,
22 September 2006, at 10.15 a.m.**

In accordance with rule 55 of the provisional rules of procedure of the Security Council, the following communiqué was issued through the Secretary-General in place of a verbatim record:

“At its 5531st (closed) meeting, held in private on 22 September 2006, the Security Council considered the item entitled ‘Security Council resolutions 1160 (1998), 1199 (1998), 1203 (1998), 1239 (1999) and 1244 (1999)’.

“The President, with the consent of the Council, invited the representatives of Albania, Finland, Germany, Italy and Serbia to participate in the consideration of the item without the right to vote, in accordance with the relevant provisions of the Charter and rule 37 of the Council’s provisional rules of procedure.

“Members of the Council and His Excellency Mr. Boris Tadić, President of the Republic of Serbia, had an exchange of views.”
