Draft conclusions proposed by the Chair

1. In response to a request by the Conference of Parties serving as the meeting of the Parties to the Kyoto Protocol (COP/MOP), at its first session,¹ the Subsidiary Body for Scientific and Technological Advice (SBSTA) considered the request made by the Government of Italy² in relation to the numerical value for forest management under Article 3, paragraph 4, of the Kyoto Protocol inscribed for Italy in the appendix to the annex to decision 16/CMP.1.
2. In its consideration, the SBSTA took into account the country-specific data on forest management activity under Article 3, paragraph 4, submitted by Italy,³ in a timely manner, as requested by the COP/MOP,⁴ in accordance with the provisions of paragraph 12 of the annex to decision 16/CMP.1.
3. The SBSTA decided to recommend a draft decision (FCCC/SBSTA/2006/L.6/Add.1) on this matter for adoption by the COP/MOP at its second session.
