The Human Rights Council,

Recalling Commission on Human Rights resolution 2005/41 of 19 April 2005,

Calls upon all States to exercise due diligence to prevent, investigate and punish the perpetrators of violence against women and girls and to provide protection to the victims, acknowledging that failure to do so violates and impairs or nullifies the enjoyment of their human rights and fundamental freedoms, and to take all necessary measures, including the adoption of a legislative framework, to this end.
