Under rule 64, paragraph 3, of the rules of procedure of the Trade and Development Board, and in accordance with the cycle of rotation for the election of the Chairperson and the Vice-Chairperson-cum-Rapporteur, the Chairperson of the Working Party at its forty-eighth session will be a representative of one of the States members in list B. The Vice-Chairperson-cum-Rapporteur will be a representative of one of the States members in list A (Asia).

2. The Working Party will be invited to approve the provisional agenda for its forty-eighth session, as reproduced in section I above.

Item 3: Review of the work programme: Draft programme budget for the biennium 2008–2009

At the ninth session of the Conference, the member States of UNCTAD invited the Secretary-General of UNCTAD to "consult with the Working Party during the preparation of the work programme and budget from the earliest stage" (TD/377). Accordingly, the Working Party will have before it a non-paper containing the first draft of UNCTAD's work programme for the 2008-2009 biennium, prepared in accordance with the instructions of the Secretary-General of the United Nations.
