Letter dated 1 March 1989 from the Permanent Representative of Lebanon to the United Nations addressed to the Secretary-General

Following the letter I addressed to you on 1 March 1989 (A/44/154-S/20495 and Corr.1), and in order to avoid any misunderstanding as to its contents, I have the honour to reaffirm categorically that the school which fell victim to the Israeli air raid is indeed a public establishment at Aïnab and that the children who were wounded are all Lebanese. As to the village of Chimlane, it is practically deserted and has no school.

I should be grateful if you would arrange to have the text of this letter circulated as a document of the General Assembly, under item 37 of the preliminary list, and of the Security Council.
