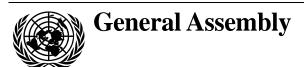

Addendum

- 1. By its decisions 2006/201 B of 10 May 2006 and 2006/201 C of 27 July 2006, the Economic and Social Council nominated five Member States for election to the Committee for Programme and Coordination by the General Assembly at its sixty-first session (see A/61/227). Also by its decision 2006/201 C, the Council postponed the nomination of two members from Western European and other States for a three-year term beginning on 1 January 2007.
- 2. At its 45th meeting, on 30 November 2006, the Economic and Social Council nominated France for election by the General Assembly for a three-year term beginning on 1 January 2007 and further postponed the nomination of one member from Western European and other States for the same term of office (see Council decision 2006/201 D).²

² There remains one vacancy in the Western European and other States group for a member whose term which would begin on the date of election and expire on 31 December 2008 (see Council decision 2006/201 A).



¹ The five States (Comoros, Haiti, Russian Federation, Venezuela (Bolivarian Republic of) and Zimbabwe) were elected by the General Assembly on 16 November 2006.
