LETTER DATED 20 SEPTEMBER 1972 FROM THE PERMANENT REPRESENTATIVES OF GUINEA, SOMALIA AND THE SUDAN ADDRESSED TO THE PRESIDENT OF THE SECURITY COUNCIL
