Report of the Second Committee*

1. At its 2nd plenary meeting, on 13 September 2006, the General Assembly, on the recommendation of the General Committee, decided to include in the agenda of its sixty-first session the item entitled:

“Training and research:

“(a) United Nations University;

“(b) United Nations Institute for Training and Research”

and to allocate it to the Second Committee.

2. The Second Committee considered the item at its 29th to 31st and 33rd meetings, on 14, 17 and 22 November and 6 December 2006. An account of the Committee’s discussion of the item is contained in the relevant summary records (A/C.2/61/SR.29-31 and 33). Attention is also drawn to the general debate held by the Committee at its 2nd to 6th meetings, on 2 to 4 October 2006 (see A/C.2/61/SR.2-6).
