

Corrigendum

1. Paragraph 128

The paragraph should read

128. As a result, 182 P-2 staff (83 per cent) moved within the first five years of their service. Of those, approximately 25 per cent were promoted and 37 per cent moved on their own laterally within or across departments, duty stations and occupational groups. Another 38 per cent were moved through managed reassignment. Of all the P-2s eligible to participate in a managed reassignment programme, 12 per cent requested deferrals for one year for various reasons, including for operational needs, such as the ability to complete a budget cycle, or for compelling personal circumstances. The remaining 5 per cent resigned from the Organization.

2. Annex, paragraph 9

The first sentence should read

As at 30 June 2006, of the 5,856 staff members of the Secretariat serving in New York, 727 have been authorized to acquire or retain United States permanent resident status, 203 of whom were in the Professional category and above and 524 in the General Service and related categories.
