LETTER DATED 3 NOVEMBER 1972 FROM THE PERMANENT REPRESENTATIVE OF INDIA TO THE UNITED NATIONS ADDRESSED TO THE PRESIDENT OF THE SECURITY COUNCIL

I have the honour to refer to the letter of 30 October 1972 from the President of the Security Council to the Secretary-General (3/10818).

During the consultations mentioned therein, the delegation of India readily concurred with the decision reflected in the second paragraph of that letter. At the same time, we expressed our views and reservations regarding the procedure followed for coming to that decision. These had been expressed earlier also (S/10709) and remain the same as on that occasion.

I would request you kindly to have this letter circulated as an official document of the Security council.
