5. At the 37th meeting, on 2 November, the representative of France, on behalf of Afghanistan, Andorra, Angola, Argentina, Armenia, Austria, Azerbaijan, Belgium, Benin, Bolivia, Bosnia and Herzegovina, Brazil, Bulgaria, Burundi, Cameroon, Cape Verde, Chile, the Congo, Costa Rica, Croatia, Cuba, Cyprus, the Czech Republic, Ecuador, Estonia, Finland, France, Gabon, Georgia, Germany, Greece, Guatemala, Guinea-Bissau, Haiti, Honduras, Hungary, Iceland, Ireland, Italy, Japan, Jordan, Latvia, Liberia, Liechtenstein, Lithuania, Luxembourg, Madagascar, Malawi, Mali, Malta, Mauritius, Mexico, Monaco, Morocco, the Netherlands, Nigeria, Norway, Panama, Paraguay, Peru, Poland, Portugal, the Republic of Korea, Romania, Senegal, Slovakia, Slovenia, South Africa, Spain, Sweden, Switzerland, Uganda, Ukraine, the United Republic of Tanzania, Uruguay and Venezuela (Bolivarian Republic of), introduced a draft resolution entitled “International Convention for the Protection of All Persons from Enforced Disappearance” (A/C.3/61/L.17). Subsequently, Albania, Botswana, Cambodia, Canada, the Central African Republic, the Comoros, Côte d’Ivoire, the Democratic Republic of the Congo, Denmark, Dominica, the Dominican Republic, Eritrea, Fiji, Indonesia, Kenya, Lebanon, Lesotho, Mauritania, Moldova, Montenegro, Nicaragua, Serbia, Sierra Leone, The former Yugoslav Republic of Macedonia, Trinidad and Tobago, Tunisia and Ukraine joined in sponsoring the draft resolution.
