^{*} Since the Danish contingent was in the process of rotation on 26 May 1972, the figures for Denmark in this tabulation are not representative of the contingent's normal strength; the discrepancy, moreover, affects the totals for UNFICYP personnel. On 3 June, the Danish contingent was back to normal strength, 17 for HQ UNFICYP and military police, and 277 for the Battalion, giving a total of 294. The 3 June figures would result in the following totals: Total military personnel: 2,986; Total UNFICYP: 3,160 (i.e. the established normal strength of UNFICYP at present).
