#### **Work of the United Nations Office on Drugs and Crime**

#### **Egypt, France, Morocco, Namibia, Nigeria, South Africa, United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland and Zimbabwe: draft decision**

The Commission on Crime Prevention and Criminal Justice recommends to the Economic and Social Council the adoption of the following draft decision:

#### **Round Table for Africa: crime and drugs as impediments to security and development in Africa: strengthening the rule of law**

The Economic and Social Council, recalling its resolution 2004/32 of 21 July 2004, entitled "Implementation of technical assistance projects in Africa by the United Nations Office on Drugs and Crime", decides to request the Secretary-General:

(a) To request the United Nations Office on Drugs and Crime to organize, using existing resources of the regular budget of the United Nations and extrabudgetary resources, the Round Table for Africa in coordination with the African Union and interested Member States, and to invite to the Round Table interested Member States, relevant agencies and institutes providing technical assistance to African States and promoting South-South cooperation;

(b) To request the United Nations Office on Drugs and Crime to convene the Round Table for Africa before the end of 2005.
