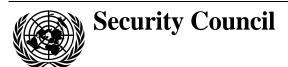

## Security Council Committee established pursuant to resolution 1737 (2006)

## Letter dated 14 February 2007 from the Permanent Representative of Albania to the United Nations addressed to the Chairman of the Committee

I write to you in your capacity as Chairman of the Security Council Committee established pursuant to resolution 1737 (2006) in order to report to the Committee on the steps my country has taken with the view to implementing effectively the aforementioned resolution.

To effectively comply with resolution 1737 (2006), the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of the Republic of Albania has circulated the full text of the resolution to all relevant institutions in Albania. This has been accompanied with the request to take all the necessary steps and measures in order to fully and effectively implement paragraphs 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8, 10, 12 and 17 of the resolution.

I would like to report and emphasize that during the requested period from December 2006 to January 2007, the Republic of Albania has fully complied with the requirements of the resolution. During that period, the Republic of Albania did not conduct any trade, or exchange of technology and goods with the Islamic Republic of Iran, as expressly stipulated in this resolution.

Albania will continue to fully comply with the provisions and requirements of Security Council resolution 1737 (2006), and report accordingly.
