**STATEMENT BY NICARAGUA ON THE HUMAN RIGHTS  
SITUATION IN DARFUR**

At its fourth special session the Human Rights Council adopted by consensus a decision on Darfur as a clear demonstration of the international community's concern at the human rights situation in Darfur.

Nicaragua regrets that the mission agreed on by consensus was unable to fulfil its mandate fully, and calls on the members of the Human Rights Council to seek, together with the Government of the Sudan, an effective means of addressing the emergency situation facing the victims, and at the same time to create conditions of trust between the parties.

The Human Rights Council stands at a crucial stage of institution-building, and so we must send clear signals of the resolve of its members to shoulder responsibly the commitments to promote and protect human rights throughout the world, and to ensure that dialogue and cooperation prevail.
