Agreement Concerning the Adoption of Uniform Conditions of Approval and Reciprocal Recognition of Approval for Motor Vehicle Equipment and Parts, done at Geneva on 20 March 1958.

The title of the Regulation, amend to read:

"UNIFORM PROVISIONS CONCERNING THE APPROVAL OF FRONT AND REAR POSITION (SIDE) LAMPS, STOP-LAMPS AND END-OUTLINE MARKER LAMPS FOR POWER-DRIVEN VEHICLES AND THEIR TRAILERS"

Insert a new paragraph 0., to read (including the insertion of a reference to a new footnote 1/ and a new footnote 1/):

"0. SCOPE

This Regulation applies to:

- 0.1. front and rear position (side) lamps and stop lamps for vehicles of categories L, M, N, O and T 1/; and,
- 0.2. end-outline marker lamps for vehicles of categories M, N, O and T.

1/ As defined in Annex 7 to the Consolidated Resolution on the Construction of Vehicles (R.E.3), (document TRANS/WP.29/78/Rev.1/Amend.2 as last amended by Amend.4)."

Paragraph 4.2.1.1., the reference to footnote 1/ and footnote 1/, renumber as footnote 2/ and amend to read:

"2/ 1 for Germany, 10 for Serbia, 48 for New Zealand, 49 for Cyprus, 50 for Malta, 51 for the Republic of Korea, 52 for Malaysia, 53 for Thailand, 54 and 55 (vacant) and 56 for Montenegro. Subsequent numbers shall be assigned"

Paragraph 6.1. (the table), the reference to footnote 1/ and footnote 1/, renumber as footnote 3/.

Paragraph 6.1. (the table), the reference to footnote 2/ and footnote 2/, renumber as footnote 4/.

Paragraph 7.2., the reference to footnote 2/ and footnote 2/, renumber as footnote 5/.
