Insert a new paragraph 0 ., to read (including the insertion of a reference to a new footnote $\underline{1 /}$ and a new footnote $1 /$ ):
"0. SCOPE
This Regulation applies to special warning lamps for vehicles of categories $\mathrm{L}, \mathrm{M}, \mathrm{N}$, O , and $\mathrm{T} \underline{1}$ / and for mobile machinery."
