The title of the Regulation, amend to read:

"UNIFORM PROVISIONS CONCERNING THE APPROVAL OF SPECIAL WARNING LAMPS FOR POWER-DRIVEN VEHICLES AND THEIR TRAILERS"

Insert a new paragraph 0., to read (including the insertion of a reference to a new footnote 1/ and a new footnote 1/):

"0. SCOPE

This Regulation applies to special warning lamps for vehicles of categories L, M, N, O, and T 1/ and for mobile machinery."

1/ As defined in Annex 7 to the Consolidated Resolution on the Construction of Vehicles (R.E.3), (document TRANS/WP.29/78/Rev.1/Amend.2 as last amended by Amend.4)."

Paragraph 4.4.1.1., the reference to footnote 1/ and footnote 1/, renumber as footnote 2/ and amend to read:

"2/ 1 for Germany, 10 for Serbia, 51 for the Republic of Korea, 52 for Malaysia, 53 for Thailand, 54 and 55 (vacant) and 56 for Montenegro. Subsequent numbers shall be assigned"
