Summary statement by the Secretary-General on matters of which the Security Council is seized and on the stage reached in their consideration

Addendum

Pursuant to rule 11 of the provisional rules of procedure of the Security Council, the Secretary-General is submitting the following summary statement.

The list of items of which the Security Council is seized is contained in documents S/2007/10 of 9 February 2007 and S/2007/10/Add.7 of 2 March 2007.

During the week ending 17 March 2007, the Security Council took action on the following items:

The situation in the Middle East, including the Palestinian question (*see*

The Security Council resumed its consideration of the item at its 5638th meeting, held on 14 March 2007 in accordance with the understanding reached in its prior consultations.

In accordance with the understanding reached in the Council's prior consultations, the President, with the consent of the Council, extended an invitation under rule 39 of the Council's provisional rules of procedure to Lynn Pascoe, Under-Secretary-General for Political Affairs.

The situation concerning Iraq (*see* S/2005/15/Add.21, 23, 24, 31, 35, 37, 44 and 49; and S/2006/10/Add.6, 10, 20, 23, 31, 36, 47 and 49)

The Security Council resumed its consideration of the item at its 5639th meeting, held on 15 March 2007 in accordance with the understanding reached in its prior consultations, having before it the report of the Secretary-General pursuant to paragraph 30 of resolution 1546 (2004) (S/2007/126).



The President, with the consent of the Council, invited the representative of Iraq, at his request, to participate in the consideration of the item without the right to vote.

In accordance with the understanding reached in the Council's prior consultations, the President, with the consent of the Council, extended an invitation under rule 39 of the Council's provisional rules of procedure to Ashraf Jehangir Qazi, Special Representative of the Secretary-General for Iraq.
