## Report of the Fifth Committee

- 1. At its 68th meeting, on 16 December 1983, the Fifth Committee, pursuant to rule 153 of the rules of procedure of the General Assembly, considered the statement by the Secretary-General (A/C.5/38/70) on the administrative and financial implications of draft resolution C recommended by the First Committee (A/38/639, para. 15), and the related report of the Advisory Committee on Administrative and Budgetary Questions (A/38/7/Add.21).
- 2. Statements and comments made in the course of the Committee's consideration of the item are reflected in the relevant summary record (A/C.5/38/SR.68).

## DECISION OF THE FIFTH COMMITTEE

3. The Fifth Committee decided, by 68 votes to 16, with 9 abstentions, to inform the General Assembly that, should it adopt draft resolution C recommended by the First Committee (A/38/639, para. 15), an additional appropriation of \$98,600 would be required under section 2B of the proposed programme budget for the biennium 1984-1985. Conference-servicing costs would arise which are estimated on a full-cost basis at \$305,500. The actual additional appropriations that might be required in this respect would be considered in the context of the consolidated statement of total conference-servicing requirements to be submitted to the General Assembly at a later stage during the current session.
