Measurement of organized crime

The Conference of the Parties to the United Nations Convention against Transnational Organized Crime:

(a) Requests its secretariat to consult with national experts on organized crime, in accordance with article 32, paragraph 3, of the United Nations Convention against Transnational Organized Crime and rule 2, paragraph 2, of the rules of procedure for the Conference of the Parties, with a view to receiving advice and assistance in the development of methodologies for the measurement of organized crime, including in the following areas:

- (i) Defining appropriate research issues for purposes of data collection;
 - (ii) Suggesting research methods and best practices;
 - (iii) Identifying sources of qualitative and quantitative information to assist in the implementation of the United Nations Convention against Transnational Organized Crime;
- (b) Requests the Secretariat to report to it on those activities.
