The meeting was called to order at 9.50 a.m.

ALLOCATION OF AGENDA ITEM 142 (THE SITUATION IN CENTRAL AMERICA: THREATS TO INTERNATIONAL PEACE AND SECURITY AND PEACE INITIATIVES) (continued)

1. The CHAIRMAN recalled that the General Assembly had decided at its 21st plenary meeting on 6 October 1983 to include in the agenda of its current session item 142 ('The situation in Central America: threats to international peace and security and peace initiatives'). At the same meeting the Assembly had taken note of the General Committee's decision to defer the question of the allocation of that item to a subsequent meeting of the Committee.
2. The sponsor of the item had proposed that it should be considered directly in plenary meeting. If there was no objection, he would take it that the Committee agreed to recommend that the item should be considered directly in plenary meeting.
