Review of logical frameworks for special political missions for the period from 1 January to 31 December 2007

Report of the Advisory Committee on Administrative and Budgetary Questions

1. The Advisory Committee has considered the report of the Secretary-General on logical frameworks for special political missions for the period from 1 January to 31 December 2007 submitted pursuant to paragraph 7, section VII, of General Assembly resolution 61/252 (A/61/890). The report of the Secretary-General contains the results of the review of the logical frameworks presented in the reports of the Secretary-General on estimates in respect of special political missions, good offices and other political initiatives authorized by the General Assembly and/or the Security Council (A/61/525 and Add.1-5).

2. In General Assembly resolution 61/252, the Secretary-General was requested to review the logical frameworks for all special political missions in order to ensure that their programmatic aspects and resource requirements were consistent with mandates of the Security Council and the Assembly and to report to it no later than the early part of the second part of its resumed sixty-first session.

3. As indicated in the report, the logical frameworks of all but three of the special political missions were in full compliance with the relevant provisions of the resolution, and programmatic aspects and resource requirements were consistent with the mandates of the Security Council and the General Assembly.

4. The Advisory Committee notes that adjustments have been made to the logical framework for the Special Envoy of the Secretary-General for the implementation of Security Council resolution 1559 (2004) and that two outputs have been added to the logical frameworks for the United Nations Peacebuilding Support Office in the Central African Republic (BONUCA) and the United Nations Peacebuilding Support Office in Guinea-Bissau (UNOGBIS).

5. The action to be taken by the General Assembly at its sixty-first session in connection with the proposed revisions to the logical framework for the period from 1 January to 31 December 2007 for the Special Envoy of the Secretary-General for



the implementation of Security Council resolution 1559 (2004), BONUCA and UNOGBIS is indicated in paragraph 7 of the report of the Secretary-General. The Advisory Committee recommends that the General Assembly take note of the report.
