Note by the Secretary-General

1. By a communication dated 9 January 1989, addressed on behalf of the Secretary-General to the States parties to the Statute of the International Court of Justice, attention was drawn to the vacancy in the International Court of Justice caused by the death, on 11 December 1988, of Judge Nagendra Singh (India). Pursuant to Article 5, paragraph 1, of the Statute of the Court, the national groups of States parties to the Statute of the Court were invited to undertake the nomination of persons in a position to accept the duties of a member of the Court and to submit such nomination to the Secretary-General no later than 4 April 1989.
2. On 6 April 1989, the Secretary-General transmitted to the General Assembly and to the Security Council, in accordance with Article 7 of the Statute of the Court, a list, in alphabetical order, of the persons nominated as at 4 April 1989 (A/43/1002-S/20552). The withdrawal of a candidate was communicated to the General Assembly and to the Security Council in an addendum to the list (A/43/1002/Add.1-S/20552/Add.1). Additional nominations received after 4 April 1989 were circulated in a separate document (A/43/1006-S/20593).
3. The composition of the Court and the voting procedure to be followed in the General Assembly and in the Security Council are contained in a memorandum by the Secretary-General issued as document A/43/1001-S/20551. The curricula vitae of the candidates appear in document A/43/1003-S/20553.
4. At its 91st plenary meeting, on 18 April 1989, the General Assembly decided to request the Secretary-General to revise the list of candidates so as to reflect the latest information received since its issuance. In response to that request, the Secretary-General has the honour to submit the attached list (see annex).
