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LETTER DATED 14 MARCH 1989 FROM THE CHARGE D'AFFAIRES A.I.
OF THE PERMANENT MISSION OF THE ISLAMIC REPUBLIC OF IRAN
TO THE UNITED NATIONS ADDRESSED TO THE SECRETARY-GENERAL

Upon instructions from my Government and pursuant to my letter dated 10 March 1989 (S/20517), I have the honour to inform you of further cease-fire violations by Iraqi forces. The numerical sequence of these violations follows the sequence in the said letter.

983. On 22 January 1989, Iraqi forces were seen constructing observation posts at the geographic coordinates of PB 795-147 on the map of Mehran.

984. On 22 January 1989, canals were dug by Iraqi forces between the geographic coordinates of PB 795-136 and PB 762-141 on the map of Mehran.

985. On 22 January 1989, two barricades were built by Iraqi forces at the geographic coordinates of NC 538-540 on the map of Sumar.

986. On 22 January 1989, Iraqi forces were seen constructing two offensive barricades at the geographic coordinates of TP 173-595 on the map of Nahr-e-Ali.

987. On 22 January 1989, a 20-metre canal was dug by Iraqi forces at the geographic coordinates of NC 537-535 on the map of Sumar.

988. On 22 January 1989, Iraqi forces built rest barricades and dug a 50 m canal at the geographic coordinates of NC 458-574 and NC 485-567 on the map of Sumar.

989. On 22 January 1989, Iraqi forces at the geographic coordinates of NF 041-295 on the map of Sar Dasht were reinforced.

990. On 22 January 1989, two observation posts were built by the Iraqis to the north-east of Konjan Cham Dam at the geographic coordinates of PB 168-149 on the map of Mehran.

991. On 22 January 1989, a 20 m canal was built by the Iraqis at the geographic coordinates of NC 537-535 on the map of Sumar.
992. On 22 January 1989, an offensive barricade was built by the Iraqis at the geographic coordinates of NC 385-566 on the map of Sumar.
993. On 22 January 1989, rest barricades and observation posts were built by Iraqi forces at the geographic coordinates of ND 021-050 on the map of Ghasr-e-Shirin and ND 030-013 on the map of Kharrat-ha.
994. At 1030 hours, on 22 January 1989, Iraqi forces were seen constructing two barricades at the geographic coordinates of NC 467-561 on the map of Sumar.
995. At 1130 hours on 22 January 1989, two barricades were constructed by the Iraqis at the geographic coordinates of NC 534-535 on the map of Sumar.
996. At 1230 hours on 22 January 1989, Iraqi forces built two offensive barricades and an approximately 15 m canal for commuting to the observation posts at the geographic coordinates of NC 534-535 on the map of Sumar.
997. On 23 January 1989, between the geographic coordinates of TP 81200-780 and TP 80100-7900, Iraqi forces fired 1,500 Dushka and Klashnikov flare bullets, wounding one Iranian personnel.
998. On 23 January 1989, Iraqi forces were seen engaged in engineering activities at the geographic coordinates of TP 177-591 and TP 150-660 on the map of Nahr-e-Ali.
999. On 23 January 1989, Iraqi forces were seen engaged in engineering activities and repairing barricades at the geographic coordinates of TP 450-464 and TP 490-454 on the maps of Abadan and Khosrow-Abad.
1000. On 23 January 1989, Iraqi forces constructed a defensive barricade at the geographic coordinates of NC 388-606 on the map of Sumar.
1001. On 23 January 1989, Iraqi forces were seen building a one-kilometre embankment at the geographic coordinates of PB 730-110 and PB 740-110 on the map of Mehran.
1002. On 23 January 1989, the Iraqis built a barricade at the geographic coordinates of NC 925-502 on the map of Sumar.
1003. At 0930 hours on 23 January 1989, Iraqi forces were photographing the Iranian defensive lines at the geographic coordinates of TP 5071-2170 on the map of Khosrow-Abad.
1004. At 1000 hours on 23 January 1989, the Iraqis were digging canals at the geographic coordinates of PB 757-143 on the map of Mehran.

1005. At 1220 hours on 23 January 1989, Iraqi forces were seen constructing barricades behind Height No. 312 at the geographic coordinates of PB 868-148 on the map of Mehran.
1006. At 1230 hours on 23 January 1989, Iraqi forces were seen constructing barricades behind Height No. 313 at the geographic coordinates of PB 768-148 on the map of Mehran.
1007. Between 2000 and 2010 hours on 23 January 1989, the Iraqis opened fire at Iranian forces with Klashnikovs at the geographic coordinates of TP 80100-17900.
1008. At 2345 hours on 23 January 1989, Iraqi forces fired eight Klashnikov bullets.
1009. On 24 January 1989, the Iraqis planted four rows of mines along 100 m of the road dividing Iranian and Iraqi forces at the geographic coordinates of ND 214-664 on the map of Ghasr-e-Shirin.
1010. On 24 January 1989, Iraqi forces stationed two tanks at the geographic coordinates of QA 984-255 and QA 964-283 on the maps of Nahr-e-Anbar and Dehloran, respectively.
1011. On 24 January 1989, the Iraqis constructed a defensive barricade at the geographic coordinates of NC 388-606 on the map of Sumar, east of Kume-Sang.
1012. On 24 January 1989, Iraqi forces brought in one more tank to the area within the geographic coordinates of QA 984-255, QA 964-272 and QA 990-240 on the maps of Dehloran and Nahr-e-Anbar.
1013. On 24 January 1989, Iraqi forces built interconnecting canals at the geographic coordinates of PB 785-145 on the map of Mehran.
1014. On 24 January 1989, the Iraqis brought in two more tanks to the field at the geographic coordinates of QA 964-283 on the maps of Dehloran and Nahr-e-Anbar.
1015. On 24 January 1989, at the geographic coordinates of QB 01-23 on the map of Dehloran, the Iraqis demolished all the baths in the city of Musian and constructed barricades instead.
1016. At 0730 hours on 24 January 1989, nine Iraqi personnel were seen digging canals at the geographic coordinates at NC 78-54 and NC 79-54 on map No. 13.
1017. At 0900 hours on 24 January 1989, five Iraqi personnel were seen constructing barricades at the geographic coordinates of QA 54-54 on the map of Yebeis.
1018. At 1000 hours on 24 January 1989, the Iraqis built barricades at the geographic coordinates of QB 013-205 on the maps of Dehloran and Nahr-e-Anbar.

1019. At 1100 hours on 24 January 1989, an Iraqi shovel was seen digging canals at the geographic coordinates of TQ 32-16 on the map of Hoseiniyeh.
1020. At 1730 hours on 24 January 1989, nine Iraqi personnel were seen digging canals at the geographic coordinates of NC 78-54 and NC 79-54 on map No. 13.
1021. At 1750 hours on 24 January 1989, Iraqi forces set up tents in the vicinities of the geographic coordinates of NC 101-055 on the map of Sar-e-Ney.
1022. On 25 January 1989, the Iraqis were in the process of adding the roof to a barricade at the geographic coordinates of NC 393-604 on the map of Sumar.
1023. At 1000 hours on 25 January 1989, five Iraqi personnel were digging canals and underground bunkers at the geographic coordinates of NC 792-550 to the east of the gendarmerie outpost.
1024. At 1400 hours on 25 January 1989, the Iraqis constructed two guard barricades at the geographic coordinates of ND 055-587 and ND 067-488 on the map of Kharrat-ha.
1025. At 1530 hours on 25 January 1989, Iraqi forces stationed four 130 mm cannons and two anti-aircraft artilleries at the geographic coordinates of QV 12000-76800 on the map of Haddadieh hill.
1026. On 26 January 1989, Iraqi forces were seen constructing two barricades and installing barbed wire at the geographic coordinates of TP 296-537 on the map of Khosrow-Abad.
1027. At between 1230 and 1440 hours on 26 January 1989, three Iraqis were constructing barricades at the geographic coordinates of NC 481-572 on the map of Sumar.
1028. At 1520 hours on 26 January 1989, an Iraqi loader was setting up tents at the geographic coordinates of NC 091-955 on the map of Sar-e-Ney.
1029. At 1530 hours on 26 January 1989, two Iraqis were constructing rest barricades at the geographic coordinates of NC 455-574 on the map of Sumar.
1030. At 1620 hours on 26 January 1989, the Iraqis were installing barbed wire at the geographic coordinates of NC 461-588 on the map of Sumar.
1031. At 0200 hours on 27 January 1989, at the geographic coordinates of TQ 0990-18200 on the map of Nud, Iraqi forces opened fire at Iranian units, wounding one Iranian personnel.
1032. At 0830 hours on 27 January 1989, eight Iraqis were constructing barricades at the geographic coordinates of NC 488-563 on the map of Sumar at Bandar-e-Pir-Ali.

1033. At 0920 hours on 27 January 1989, 13 Iraqis were installing barbed wire at the geographic coordinates of TQ 2?-17 on the map of Hoseiniyeh.
1034. At 1040 hours on 27 January 1989, the Iraqis were repairing a watch barricade at the geographic coordinates of PB 670-080 on the map of Mehran, east of Farah-Abad.
1035. At 1630 hours on 27 January 1989, the Iraqis constructed a watch barricade on Height No. 428 at the geographic coordinates of ND 221-501 on the map of Ghasr-e-Shirin.
1036. At 1700 hours on 27 January 1989, the Iraqis built an offensive barricade at the geographic coordinates of NC 519-551 on the map of Sumar, south-west of Orduban.
1037. On 28 January 1989, Iraqi forces constructed a watch-tower at the geographic coordinates of TQ 07000-15500, TQ 09000-15500 and 11800-15600 on the map of Kharmal.
1038. On 28 January 1989, the Iraqi forces were doubled in strength in the Cheshmeh Makki area at the geographic coordinates of NC 42-58 and NC 41-59 on the map of Sumar.
1039. On 28 January 1989, the Iraqis built a group barricade at the geographic coordinates of PB 763-079 on the map of Mehran.
1040. On 28 January 1989, the Iraqis converted one of their watch posts into a group barricade at the geographic coordinates of PB 677-084 on the map of Mehran.
1041. By 28 January 1989, the Iraqis had been constructing embankments for three days using two loaders and two bulldozers at the geographic coordinates of PB 665-028, PB 672-038 and PB 677-054 on the map of Mehran.
1042. On 28 January 1989, the Iraqis were building four barricades at the geographic coordinates of TP 12-07 on the map of Nahr-e-Ali-Shir.
1043. At 1010 hours on 28 January 1989, the Iraqis built one barricade at the geographic coordinates of NC 501-559 on the map of Sumar.
1044. At 1100 hours on 28 January 1989, six Iraqis were building barricades at the geographic coordinates of QA 53-55 on the map of Einkhosh.
1045. At 1300 hours on 28 January 1989, an IFA vehicle unloaded some 20 boxes of ammunition and distributed them among the barricades at 1700 hours in the vicinities of the geographic coordinates of NC 419-581 on the map of Sumar.
1046. On 29 January 1989, the Iraqis built a watch-tower across Height No. 28 at the geographic coordinates of TP 84900-14150 on the map of Nud.

1047. On 29 January 1989, the Iraqis were building a fortress and probably raising the banks of the island in the Omm-o-Rasas region.

1048. On 29 January 1989, an anti-aircraft unit was stationed at the geographic coordinates of TP 83800-15700 on the map of Nud.

1049. On 29 January 1989, the building of embankments, started four days earlier, was completed between the geographic coordinates of PB 735-105 and PB 741-1006 and at PB 743-108 on the map of Mehran.

1050. On 29 January 1989, four 105 mm cannons were withdrawn and 27 were deployed at the geographic coordinates of TP 84300-15400 on the map of Nud.

1051. At 0512 hours on 29 January 1989, the Iraqis were planting mines at the geographic coordinates of NC 492-563 on the map of Sumar.

1052. At 0825 hours on 29 January 1989, the Iraqis were constructing fortifications at the geographic coordinates of PB 670-070 and PB 660-070 on the map of Mehran.

1053. At 1100 hours on 29 January 1989, over 1,501 instances of explosions and grassland fires occurred on Minu Island at the geographic coordinates of TP 625-294 on the map of Khoramshahr.

1054. At 1115 hours on 29 January 1989, embankments were being made with two bulldozers and five loaders at the geographic coordinates of PB 68-05 on the map of Mehran.

1055. At 1130 hours on 29 January 1989, four Iraqis were carrying traverse at the geographic coordinates of NC 485-525 on the map of Sumar.

1056. At 1130 hours on 29 January 1989, the Iraqis descended the hill by the road at the geographic coordinates of NC 386-606 and NC 382-612 on the map of Sumar and proceeded to block the road by installing barbed wire but were stopped by Iranian forces.

1057. At 1450 hours on 29 January 1989, five Iraqis were constructing barricades at the geographic coordinates of QA 57-54 on the map of Yebeis.

1058. At 1530 hours on 29 January 1989, three Iraqis were repairing canals at the geographic coordinates of NC 464-580 on the map of Sumar.

1059. At 1810 hours on 29 January 1989, the Iraqis were installing barbed wire and setting up a road-block with stones at the geographic coordinates of NC 386-606 and NC 382-612 on the map of Sumar.

1060. From 29 January 1989 to 4 February 1989, the Iraqis were building new trenches and repairing the old ones in the vicinities of the geographic coordinates of PB 67-04 and PB 680-040 on the map of Mehran.

1061. On 30 January 1989, two barricades were built at the geographic coordinates of TP 502-441 on the map of Abadan.
1062. On 30 January 1989, the Iraqis were engaged in engineering activities at the geographic coordinates of TP 692-274 on the map of Khoramshahr.
1063. On 30 January 1989, three barricades were constructed at the geographic coordinates of TP 494-448 on the map of Abadan and Khosrow-Abad.
1064. On 30 January 1989, as also reported to the United Nations Iran-Iraq Military Observer Group (UNIIMOG), the Iraqis set up observation tents at the geographic coordinates of ND 221-501 on the map of Ghasr-e-Shirin.
1065. At 0610 hours on 30 January 1989, sequential explosions were heard and concrete barricades were constructed at the geographic coordinates at TP 682-278 and TP 628-292 respectively, on the map of Kharamshahr.
1066. At 0925 hours on 30 January 1989, five Iraqis were constructing watch barricades at the geographic coordinates of NC 535-535 on the map of Sumar.
1067. At 0925 hours on 30 January 1989, two Iraqis were digging canals at the geographic coordinates of PB 680-070 on the map of Mehran.
1068. At 1000 hours on 30 January 1989, two bulldozers and two loaders were building embankments at the geographic coordinates at PB 680-050 on the map of Mehran.
1069. At 1050 hours on 30 January 1989, nine Iraqis were digging canals at the geographic coordinates of ND 115-475 and ND 111-771 on the map of Kharrat-ha.
1070. At 0620 hours on 31 January 1989, an Iraqi bulldozer was building a barricade at the geographic coordinates of PB 882-025 on the map of Saleh-Abad.
1071. At 0900 hours on 31 January 1989, 10 Iraqis were building observation posts at the geographic coordinates of PB 882-025 on the map of Saleh-Abad.
1072. At 1030 hours on 31 January 1989, Iraqi loaders were building roads and constructing barricades at the geographic coordinates of NC 004-989 on the map of Sumar.
1073. At 1080 hours on 31 January 1989, canals were being built at the geographic coordinates of NC 144-891 on the map of Hallaleh.
1074. At 1100 hours on 31 January 1989, six Iraqis were building rest barricades at the geographic coordinates of NC 488-561 on the map of Sumar.
1075. At 1630 hours on 31 January 1989, an observation post was being built at the geographic coordinates of QB 005-164 on the map of Dehloran.
