Counsellor for Host Country Affairs of the United States Mission  
to the United Nations addressed to the Chairman of the Committee**

The United States Mission to the United Nations presents its compliments to the Permanent Mission of Cuba to the United Nations and has the honour to refer to the latter's note verbale number NV 2017 of 9 May 2007. The United States Mission and the Department of State have reviewed background information related to the denial of a visa to Fabiola Mora, a representative of the Cuban non-governmental organization National Union of Writers and Artists of Cuba. It appears that Mrs. Mora inadvertently was denied a visa, and was therefore unable to participate in the fifty-first session of the Commission on the Status of Women from 26 February to 9 March. Had the Permanent Mission of Cuba notified the United States Mission of the denial of Mrs. Mora's visa when it occurred, this Mission could have informed the appropriate host country authorities that immediate corrective action was required.
