LETTER DATED 14 DECEMBER 1983 FROM THE PERMANENT REPRESENTATIVE OF ANGOLA TO THE UNITED NATIONS ADDRESSED TO THE PRESIDENT OF THE SECURITY COUNCIL

In view of the threat to regional and international peace and security represented by the occupation since 1981 of parts of southern Angola by the racist Armed Forces of South Africa, resulting in the violation of the territorial integrity and national sovereignty of the People's Republic of Angola, including the increase in the acts of aggression and violence perpetuated by the racist régime against the people of Angola, my Government requests that an urgent meeting of the Security Council be convened to deal with the situation.
