## Implementation of Security Council resolution 1747 (2007) by Pakistan

In accordance with section 2 of Pakistan's United Nations (Security Council) Act, 1948, a Gazette Notification was issued on 3 April 2007\* to give effect to the provisions of Security Council resolution 1747 dated 24 March 2007 in Pakistan.\* The Gazette Notification provides legal basis for measures by all concerned persons in Pakistan towards the implementation of the resolution 1747.

The aforementioned Gazette Notification is in addition to Gazette Notification No. S.R.O. 65(I)/2007 dated 23 January 2007,\* issued by the Government of Pakistan to give effect to Security Council resolution 1737 of 23 December 2006, the measures prescribed in which to continue to remain in force, in addition to the measures which are being implemented pursuant to Security Council resolution 1747 by Pakistan.
