REPORT BY THE SECRETARY-GENERAL TO THE PRESIDENT OF THE  
SECURITY COUNCIL CONCERNING THE CREDENTIALS OF THE  
REPRESENTATIVE OF GUATEMALA TO THE SECURITY COUNCIL

Pursuant to rules 14 and 15 of the provisional rules of procedure of the Security Council, the Secretary-General wishes to report that he has received a cablegram dated 20 June 1954 from the Minister for External Relations of Guatemala stating that the Government of Guatemala has appointed Dr. Eduardo Castillo-Arriola as representative of Guatemala to the Security Council for the discussion of the cablegram dated 19 June 1954 from the Minister for External Relations of Guatemala addressed to the President of the Security Council.

In the opinion of the Secretary-General, this cablegram constitutes adequate provisional credentials.
