LETTER DATED 20 JUNE 1954 FROM THE REPRESENTATIVE OF CUBA
ADDRESSED TO THE PRESIDENT OF THE SECURITY COUNCIL

With reference to the note addressed to you by the representative of Guatemala to the United Nations requesting that the Security Council should be convened to investigate the present situation in Guatemala, I have the honour, acting upon my Government's instructions, to advise you as follows:

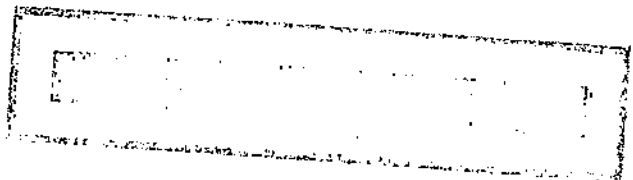
It is the understanding of the Government of Cuba that, under Articles 33 and 52 of the United Nations Charter, the question referred to has first to be considered by the appropriate bodies of the Organization of American States, which bodies must exhaust such possibilities of action as our inter-American system affords in such cases.
