LETTER DATED 2 JULY 1954 FROM THE REPRESENTATIVE OF ISRAEL ADDRESSED  
TO THE PRESIDENT OF THE SECURITY COUNCIL

Excellency,

Further to my letter of 1 July 1954, I have the honour to submit the following additional information concerning Jordanian attacks in Jerusalem:

On 1 July 1954 sniping from Jordanian positions continued until 21:00 hours.

Today, 2 July 1954, firing across the Demarcation Line was reopened at about 06:00 hours and has continued since. Up to noon, one Israeli soldier has been killed and 4 civilians, including 2 children, wounded.

The total number of casualties in Israel reported so far is 2 killed and 27 wounded.

I have the honour to request that this information be made available to the members of the Security Council and be circulated among all members of the United Nations.

Please accept, Excellency, the assurances of my highest consideration.
