Addendum

Pursuant to rule 11 of the provisional rules of procedure of the Security Council, the Secretary-General is submitting the following summary statement.

The list of items of which the Security Council is seized is contained in document S/16270 of 11 January 1984.

During the week ending 4 February 1984, the Security Council took action on the following item:

Letter dated 3 February 1984 from the Chargé d'affaires a.i. of the Permanent Mission of Nicaragua to the United Nations addressed to the President of the Security Council

In a letter dated 3 February 1984 addressed to the President of the Security Council (S/16306), the representative of Nicaragua requested that an immediate meeting of the Security Council be convened for the purpose of considering the situation created by the new escalation of acts of aggression to which his country had been subjected by Somozist and mercenary counter-revolutionary forces trained and financed by the United States of America.

The Security Council considered the item at its 2513th meeting, held on 3 February 1984.

In the course of the meeting, the President, with the consent of the Council, invited the representative of Honduras, at his request, to participate in the discussion without the right to vote.
