Summary statement by the Secretary-General on matters of which the Security Council is seized and on the stage reached in their consideration

Addendum

Pursuant to rule 11 of the provisional rules of procedure of the Security Council, the Secretary-General is submitting the following summary statement.

The list of items of which the Security Council is seized is contained in documents S/2007/10 of 9 February 2007, S/2007/10/Add.7 of 2 March 2007, S/2007/10/Add.12 of 5 April 2007 and S/2007/10/Add.15 of 27 April 2007.

During the week ending 19 May 2007, the Security Council took action on the following items:

The Security Council resumed its consideration of the item at its 5674th meeting, held on 15 May 2007 in accordance with the understanding reached in its prior consultations, having before it the twenty-third report of the Secretary-General on the United Nations Organization Mission in the Democratic Republic of the Congo (S/2007/156).

The President, with the consent of the Council, invited the representative of the Democratic Republic of the Congo, at his request, to participate in the consideration of the item without the right to vote.

The President drew attention to a draft resolution (S/2007/271) that had been prepared in the course of the Council's prior consultations.

The Security Council proceeded to vote on draft resolution S/2007/271, and adopted it unanimously as resolution 1756 (2007) (for the text, see S/RES/1756 (2007); to be issued in *Official Records of the Security Council, Resolutions and Decisions of the Security Council, 1 August 2006-31 July 2007*).

The Security Council resumed its consideration of the item at its 5675th meeting, held on 16 May 2007 in accordance with the understanding reached in its prior consultations, having before it a letter dated 3 May 2007 from the Secretary-General addressed to the President of the Security Council (S/2007/253).

The President, with the consent of the Council, invited the representatives of Bosnia and Herzegovina and Germany, at their request, to participate in the consideration of the item without the right to vote.

In accordance with the understanding reached in the Council's prior consultations, the President, with the consent of the Council, extended an invitation under rule 39 of the Council's provisional rules of procedure to Christian Schwarz-Schilling, High Representative for the Implementation of the Peace Agreement on Bosnia and Herzegovina.

The Security Council resumed its consideration of the item at its 5676th meeting, held on 18 May 2007 in accordance with the understanding reached in its prior consultations, having before it the thirteenth progress report of the Secretary-General on the United Nations Operation in Côte d'Ivoire (S/2007/275).

The President, with the consent of the Council, invited the representatives of Burkina Faso and Côte d'Ivoire, at their request, to participate in the consideration of the item without the right to vote.
