### **Report of the Fifth Committee**

## I. Introduction

1. The previous recommendations made by the Fifth Committee to the General Assembly under agenda item 117 appear in the reports of the Committee contained in documents A/61/592 and Add.1-4.

2. The Fifth Committee resumed its consideration of the item at its 52nd, 54th, 55th and 58th meetings, on 24 and 29 May and 1 and 27 June 2007. Statements and observations made in the course of the Committee's consideration of the item are reflected in the relevant summary records (A/C.5/61/SR.52, 54, 55 and 58).

3. For its further consideration of the item, the Committee had before it the following documents:

## II. Consideration of draft resolution A/C.5/61/L.54

At its 58th meeting, on 27 June, the Committee had before it a draft resolution entitled "Special subjects relating to the programme budget for the biennium 2006-2007" (A/C.5/61/L.54), submitted by the Chairman of the Committee on the basis of informal consultations coordinated by the representatives of Kenya, Angola and Greece, also a Vice-Chairman of the Committee.

*Having considered* the reports of the Secretary-General on the revised estimates resulting from decision S-4/101 adopted by the Human Rights Council at its fourth special session in 2006 and on the revised estimates resulting from resolutions adopted by the Human Rights Council at its fourth session in 2007<sup>1</sup> and the related report of the Advisory Committee on Administrative and Budgetary Questions,<sup>2</sup>

1. *Takes note* of the reports of the Secretary-General on the revised estimates resulting from decision S-4/101 adopted by the Human Rights Council at its fourth special session in 2006 and on the revised estimates resulting from resolutions adopted by the Human Rights Council at its fourth session in 2007;<sup>1</sup>

2. *Endorses* the conclusions and recommendations contained in the report of the Advisory Committee on Administrative and Budgetary Questions;<sup>2</sup>

## Financial situation of the International Research and Training Institute for the Advancement of Women

Recalling its decision 61/555 of 4 April 2007,

*Having considered* the report of the Secretary-General on the financial situation of the International Research and Training Institute for the Advancement of Women<sup>3</sup> and the related report of the Advisory Committee on Administrative and Budgetary Questions,<sup>4</sup>

1. *Takes note* of the report of the Secretary-General;<sup>3</sup>

2. *Endorses* the conclusions and recommendations contained in the report of the Advisory Committee on Administrative and Budgetary Questions,<sup>4</sup> subject to the provisions of the present resolution;

3. *Reaffirms* that regular budget resources shall not be used to finance the activities of the Institute, in accordance with articles VI and VII of its statute;

4. *Notes* that the International Research and Training Institute for the Advancement of Women has previously asked for supplementary funds from the regular budget on an exceptional basis;

5. *Reiterates* its appeal to Member States, as a matter of urgency, to contribute voluntary funds in support of the Institute and to honour existing pledges;

6. *Calls upon* the Institute to formulate its budget in such a way as to align it more closely with the volume of voluntary resources available to it;

7. *Calls upon* the Secretary-General, in his report on the Institute to the General Assembly at its sixty-second session, to offer solutions for placing the financial situation of the Institute on a more stable basis without recourse to regular budget funding, in line with the statute of the Institute;

8. *Decides*, on an exceptional basis, to authorize the Secretary-General to enter into commitments in an amount up to 367,800 United States dollars under section 9, Economic and social affairs, of the programme budget for the biennium 2006-2007, subject to full reimbursement, pending receipt of voluntary contributions;
