Convention (E/794)

...
In this Convention genocide means any of the following acts committed
with the intent to destroy, in whole or in part, a national, ethnical,
racial, religious or political group, as such:

- (1) Killing members of the group;
 - (2) Causing serious bodily or mental harm to members of the group;
 - (3) The deliberate infliction of conditions of life for such groups as
are calculated to bring about their physical destruction in whole or in part;
 - (4) Imposing measures intended to prevent births within the group;
 - (5) Forced transfer of children to another human group.
