### Note by the secretariat

It is recalled that the Working Party on Inland Water Transport at its special session envisaged bringing section 2-7 "official number" of the annex to resolution No. 61 in line with relevant provisions on unique European Identification Number of Annex II to EC Directive replacing directive 82/714/EEC (ECE/TRANS/SC.3/171, para. 6 (vi)). At its fiftieth session, SC.3 referred the issue to Working Party SC.3/WP.3 (ECE/TRANS/SC.3/174, para. 39), which considered it and asked the secretariat to prepare a draft of the revised section 2.7 for the SC.3 fifty-first session (ECE/TRANS/SC.3/WP.3/62, para.19).

The Working Party may wish to consider the new wording of section 2-7 proposed in the document and to decide whether to endorse the amendments. Additions to the original text are highlighted in bold and the text to eliminate is struck-through.

# I. RECOMMENDATIONS ON HARMONIZED EUROPE-WIDE TECHNICAL REQUIREMENTS FOR INLAND NAVIGATION VESSELS (RESOLUTION NO. 61)

1. <u>To change section 2-7 "Official Number" as follows</u>

### 2-7 OFFICIAL NUMBER

- 2-7.1 The competent authority issuing a certificate shall enter on that certificate the official number assigned to that vessel by the competent authority of the State in which the vessel has been registered or has its home port.
- 2-7.2 The official number shall consist of eight Arabic numerals, as follows:

The first two or three digits shall indicate the country and place where the official number was assigned competent authority of the State in which the vessel has been registered or has its home port and which assigned the number. For this purpose the following key shall apply:

The next five or six digits of the official number shall indicate the serial number in the register kept by the competent authority.

2-7.3 The official number shall remain invariable throughout the existence of the vessel. However, if that vessel is registered in another State or if its home port is transferred there, the official number shall no longer be valid. The ship's certificate shall then be submitted to a competent authority on the inspection of vessels which shall delete the official number that has ceased to be valid and, if necessary, shall enter the new official number.
