Summary statement by the Secretary-General on matters of which the Security Council is seized and on the stage reached in their consideration

Addendum

Pursuant to rule 11 of the provisional rules of procedure of the Security Council, the Secretary-General is submitting the following summary statement.

The list of items of which the Security Council is seized is contained in documents S/2007/10 of 9 February 2007, S/2007/10/Add.7 of 2 March 2007, S/2007/10/Add.12 of 5 April 2007, S/2007/10/Add.15 of 27 April 2007, S/2007/10/Add.20 of 1 June 2007 and S/2007/10/Add.25 of 6 July 2007.

During the week ending 11 August 2007, the Security Council took action on the following items:

The situation concerning Iraq (*see* S/2005/15/Add.21, 23, 24, 31, 35, 37, 44 and 49; S/2006/10/Add.6, 10, 20, 23, 31, 36, 47 and 49; and S/2007/10/Add.10, 20, 23 and 25)

The Security Council resumed its consideration of the item at its 5729th meeting, held on 10 August 2007 in accordance with the understanding reached in its prior consultations.

The President, with the consent of the Council, invited the representative of Iraq, at his request, to participate in the consideration of the item without the right to vote.

The President drew attention to a draft resolution (S/2007/482) submitted by Italy, Panama, Slovakia, the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland and the United States of America.

The Security Council proceeded to vote on draft resolution S/2007/482, and adopted it unanimously as resolution 1770 (2007) (for the text, see S/RES/1770 (2007); to be issued in *Official Records of the Security Council, Resolutions and Decisions of the Security Council, 1 August 2006-31 July 2007*).



The situation concerning the Democratic Republic of the Congo (*see* S/1997/40/Add.21; S/1998/44/Add.35 and 49; S/1999/25/Add.10, 13, 24, 30, 43, 47 and 49; S/2000/40/Add.3, 7, 16, 17, 19, 21, 23, 30, 33, 40, 47 and 49; S/2001/15/Add.5, 8, 18, 24, 30, 35, 36, 43, 45, 50 and 51; S/2002/30/Add.4, 8, 11, 20, 22, 23, 29, 31, 32, 36, 41, 42, 44 and 48; S/2003/40/Add.3, 6, 11, 19, 21, 25, 27, 28, 30, 32, 34 and 46; S/2004/20/Add.2, 10, 19, 23, 25, 30, 39 and 49; S/2005/15/Add.8, 12, 14, 15, 25, 27, 29, 35, 38, 39, 42 and 50; S/2006/10/Add.3, 4, 14, 16, 25, 30, 37, 38, 44, 48 and 50; and S/2007/10/Add.1, 13, 14, 19, 29 and 30)

The Security Council resumed its consideration of the item at its 5730th meeting, held on 10 August 2007 in accordance with the understanding reached in its prior consultations, having before it a letter dated 16 July 2007 from the Chairman of the Security Council Committee established pursuant to resolution 1533 (2004) concerning the Democratic Republic of the Congo addressed to the President of the Security Council (S/2007/423).

The President, with the consent of the Council, invited the representative of the Democratic Republic of the Congo, at his request, to participate in the consideration of the item without the right to vote.

The President drew attention to a draft resolution (S/2007/485) submitted by France.

The Security Council proceeded to vote on draft resolution S/2007/485, and adopted it unanimously as resolution 1771 (2007) (for the text, see S/RES/1771 (2007); to be issued in *Official Records of the Security Council, Resolutions and Decisions of the Security Council, 1 August 2006-31 July 2007*).
