DRAFT WORKPLAN FOR THE IMPLEMENTATION OF THE CONVENTION ON LONG-RANGE TRANSBOUNDARY AIR POLLUTION IN 2008

Note by the secretariat

- 1. In 2005, the secretariat adopted new procedures for developing the workplan of the Convention, which were aimed at greater transparency and efficiency (EB.AIR/2005/6). The Executive Body, at its twenty-fourth session, agreed that the new procedures had worked well in 2005 and 2006 and requested that the same procedures be used for the future.
- 2. To this end, the Working Group on Effects, the EMEP¹ Steering Body, and the Working Group on Strategies and Review have each considered their respective 2008 workplans. These

workplans, as amended by each of the above subsidiary bodies (ECE/EB.AIR/2007/7, ECE/EB.AIR/2007/8 and ECE/EB.AIR/2007/9, respectively), together with the draft 2008 workplan of the Implementation Committee (ECE/EB.AIR/2007/3, annex), are submitted to the Executive Body for its consideration.

- 3. The Executive Body is expected to agree on its workplan for 2008, which will, like the 2007 workplan, be made available on the Convention's website in English, French and Russian.
- 4. In view of the Executive Body's deliberations under item 13 of the agenda, and the proposals made by the secretariat in document ECE/EB.AIR/2007/11 (Documentation for the Convention), the Executive Body may wish to agree to the publication of the workplan as a post-session document and to confirm procedures for amending the workplan by decision of the Bureau through the issue of corrigenda by the secretariat.
