LETTER DATED 7 JANUARY 1964 FROM THE PERMANENT REPRESENTATIVE
OF TURKEY ADDRESSED TO THE PRESIDENT OF THE SECURITY COUNCIL

With reference to the letter dated 2 January 1964, (Doc. S/5502) addressed to Your Excellency by Ambassador Z. Rosvidas, which contains completely unfounded allegations against my Government, I would like to bring to the notice of Your Excellency and of the members of the Security Council the following:

I am in a position to refute and answer the assertions of Ambassador Rosvidas and will not hesitate to do so when I deem it necessary.

However, at a time when efforts are being made to secure peace in Cyprus and, in view of the forthcoming London Conference between the United Kingdom, Greece and Turkey and the representatives of the Greek and Turkish communities on the island, and in the spirit needed for a more suitable atmosphere for the success of this Conference, I prefer to withhold my reply to the allegations in question.

I request Your Excellency to be good enough to circulate this communication as an official document of the Security Council.
