Addendum

In paragraph 23 of my report to the Security Council of 2 January 1964 (S/5501), I indicated that it was my intention to maintain the United Nations Observation Mission in Yemen for at least another two months. That intention has been carried out and the Mission continues. In pursuance of the informal procedure followed last November (S/5447/Add.2), although believing that no meeting of the Council on the subject was required, I have consulted the Council members informally in order to ascertain that in the light of the circumstances as reported there would be no objection to the extension. There was none.
