To shoy how untenable and irreoponsible this atnetament 1s, oue wead only mention that ovon $14{ }^{\prime}$ sid the conotitutional amondments proposed by the Prosident $a$ to whioh he olvisourly rotors - ware adoptod, the wighto of the ruxstion winowity in Cyprus would be far In exoese of the righte enjoyoch by any other minowty in any past of the woild.

Even the unparailoiod overprividoces of the Iturkioh minoxity, ouch as for Instance its 30 pox cont representadiou in the $2 e g i a l a t u r e$, whilo ite popuiation ratio 10 leos than 18 per coat, were unafreotiod by the propesed anondmontr. This moans that unoquai poiltioal righto, ateariminating in favour of the murkd ah, and ageinat the Greok, oiticens would continue.

Furthermore by theo emendments acidtionad riehto were given to the Turksoh minority, The Turisiah VioenPresident of the Rapubila would bo entitised to deputize for the Prosident during the Latter's absence or incepaoity; and the some would apply to the Turkish Vheomprodgdent of the llouse of noprosentatives In the absence or Lhonpasity of its Dresident. these richtes, undor the existine provialons, devoive omly on arack oftilotala.

The other points ware mainly admed at doing away with diviaive and disoriminatory provisione in the Conatitution, suoh ao divided toms, divided Courts of Justice, divided majorities in the legialature, and other diviaiono, Which as exparienoe has demonstrated cive no actual benesits to the Tunke, but are unworkable and equally deatruotive to both communtiles and the popuzation as a whole. Wores atili, by thoir very diviadveness those provialone had booome a growing ceuse of antagoniom and friation whioh hed up to the prosent arisio. However, Wr. Dowktash would seem to be more ocncenned with retaining and accontumtiug division as a means to partition, rathor than with tho walfure of the Murisiah minority, Por paritition, with an ose to annexation, is the poiloy pursued by the Iurkioh Government through its extremiat agonts in Cyprus. It io in thio pursuance of thia aim that the Constitution, in the eyes of tha Iurkioh Government, muat remain divisive and umorkabio - that tudkion extremiam in Cyprus must be oncouraged to intarwaomanal olashes rad to that end the expatation of militury intervention from Ihurkey must bo kept ailve through the somalled 1 ruaty of Ounranteo, so that the Rogublic of Cyprus-may finctily vo dicruptad.

The roet of the lodter ixreaponsibly repaata $200 s 0$ and whoily unfounded ohasges of "masoarse" and "genootede" with an op ie in the javish use of the wordo obaractoristio of partioular historio assoclation with thom. Howover, the doctrine "cgiomnter, oalounter in reatera toujourb quelque ohoog" has nevor derved a good or a true oause amd never Iinally provailed.

The recent events in Cyprus are indeed most recrettaila. Partioularity as the deutiny of this daland hae boen, and is, that of a bridee of unity and not of n focus or friction and violence to which the turkieh partition policy hew broucht to $1 t$. The ubvious canse and the dabtruaent of intermcormunal troubla whouid be olinumated if poace is to roturn to the Leland and comoperation amonce the various sections of its people be resuned.
