REPORT BY THE SECRETARY-GENERAL ON THE ORGANIZATION AND OPERATION
OF THE UNITED NATIONS PEACE-KEEPING FORCE IN CYPRUS

1. Pursuant to the provisions of the resolution adopted by the Security Council on 4 March 1964 (S/5575) and having received the consent of the Government of Cyprus to the creation of the Force (S/5578), I have appointed Lieutenant General P.S. Gyani as Commander of the United Nations Peace-Keeping Force in Cyprus. General Gyani will take up his appointment and assume command immediately after the establishment of the Force.
2. I have approached several Governments about the provision of contingents for the Force and their replies are expected shortly. In accordance with the resolution, I am also consulting with the Governments of Cyprus, Greece, Turkey and the United Kingdom as to the composition and size of the Force. The Security Council will be kept informed about developments in this regard.
3. General Gyani has intimated to me his intention, subject to the concurrence of the Government of the United Kingdom, to appoint Major General R.N.P. Carver, the present Commander of the joint peace-keeping force, as Deputy Commander of the United Nations Force, upon its establishment.
