LETTER DATED 6 MAY 1964 FROM THE PERMANENT REPRESENTATIVE OF TURKEY ADDRESSED TO THE PRESIDENT OF THE SECURITY COUNCIL

PRESIDENT SECURITY COUNCIL UNITED NATIONS

"RELIABLE INFORMATION WHICH JUST REACHED ME TO THE EFFECT THAT THREE PLANES OF THE AIR FORCE OF GREECE HAVE BEEN VIOLATING THE AIR SPACE OF THE REPUBLIC OF CYPRUS BY FLYING ON 25 AND 30 APRIL AND 1 AND 4 MAY OVER TWO AREAS BETWEEN KOKKINA AND GIRNE ON THE NCRTHWEST CCAST OF THE ISLAND.

I PROTEST MOST STRONGLY AGAINST THIS ACTION ON THE PART OF GREECE WHICH IS INDICATIVE OF THE PART PLAYED BY THAT COUNTRY AND OF ITS COMPLICITY IN "HE ATTACKS WHICH GREEKS IN CYPRUS HAVE BEEN WAGING AGAINST TURKISH CYPRICIES SINCE LAST DECEMBER."
