ADDENDUM

The Secretary-General has the honour to report to the Security Council that he has received one additional reply to his letter to Member States in connexion with the resolution adopted by the Security Council on 4 December 1963 (S/5471). The substantive part of this reply is reproduced below:

The position of the Austrian Government with regard to operative paragraph 1 of Security Council resolution S/5471 of 4 December 1963 has been set out in document S/5438 of 11 October 1963, which contains the replies of Member States to the Secretary-General's inquiry on the implementation of Security Council resolution S/5386 of 7 August 1963. There has been no change in the Austrian Government's attitude not to permit the sale or shipment to South Africa of military vehicles, arms and ammunition likely to be used in the enforcement of the policy of apartheid.

As regards operative paragraph 5 of Security Council resolution S/5471, the Austrian Government notes that Austria does not export to the Republic of South Africa machines designed for the manufacture of military arms and ammunition.
