REPORT BY THE SECRETARY-GENERAL TO THE PRESIDENT OF THE SECURITY COUNCIL  
CONCERNING THE CREDENTIALS OF THE REPRESENTATIVE AND ALTERNATE  
REPRESENTATIVES OF CUBA ON THE SECURITY COUNCIL

Pursuant to rule 15 of the provisional rules of procedure of the Security Council, the Secretary-General wishes to report that he has received a letter dated 5 December 1955 from the Minister of Foreign Affairs of Cuba stating that Mr. Emilio Nuñez Portuondo has been appointed representative of Cuba on the Security Council. The letter further states that Mr. Carlos Blanco Sánchez and Mr. José Miguel Ribas have been appointed alternate representatives of Cuba on the Security Council.

In the opinion of the Secretary-General these credentials are in order.
