LETTER DATED 10 JUNE 1964 FROM THE FERMANENT REPRESENTATIVE OF HAITI ADDRESSED TO THE PRESIDENT OF THE SECURITY COUNCIL

In the reply of Mr. Guaroa Velázquez, Ambassador of the Dominican Republic, to the cable addressed to you by Foreign Minister Chalmers, I note, not without some regret for the truth, that the Ambassador has passed over in silence the essential part of his representations, namely, that in the event of a repetition of the occurrences alleged by him, "the Dominican Government would open fire on the frontier".

I deem it absolutely indispensable to the complete information of international opinion to point out this oversight which found its way all too readily into Ambassador Velázquez's corrective note.

I should be grateful if you would circulate this communication as an official Security Council document.
