Your Excellency,

In my telegram to you of the 24th June, in addition to two other matters, I invited your attention to the arrival in Cyprus of General Grivas. Since then General Grivas has made his position clear by stating publicly that he has come to Cyprus as a missionary of the idea of union of Cyprus with mother Greece. He also stated that as a fighter he will unify all the forces of Cyprus for the achievement of this goal. Needless to say, such activity by a notorious guerilla fighter is certainly a violation of the resolution of the Security Council and is of such a nature which does not only prejudice the work of the United Nations Mediator but makes it impossible.

It is no longer a secret that General Grivas after having worked in the Ministry of Defense in Greece for some months has been sent to Cyprus by the Government of Greece in order to forestall an agreed political solution. I hope you will agree with me that it is high time for the United Nations to clarify its position in Cyprus vis-a-vis the Enochia activities upon which the Greek Government, Greek nationals and Greek Cypriots have openly embarked.
